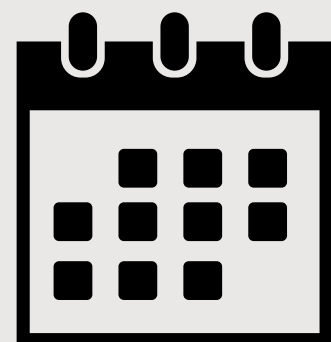


# Milton Township Community Mental Health (708) Board

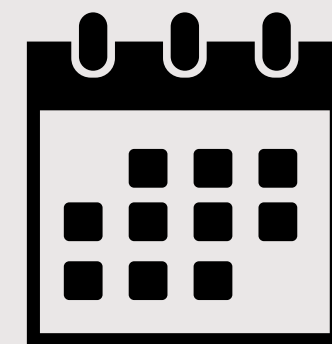
# Seniors and Law Enforcement Together (S.A.L.T.)

---

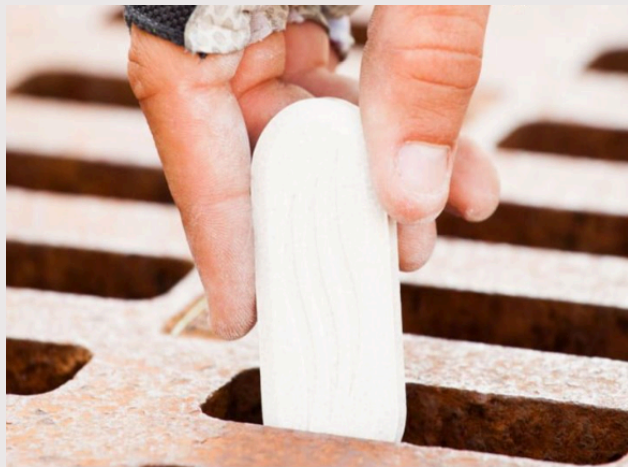

<b>0</b> NONE	Off season, mosquitoes not active, climate not favorable for <i>Culex</i> species.	None required
<b>1</b> LOW	Localized abundance of active mosquitoes, climate conditions favorable for development of virus.	Reduce, Repel, Report
<b>2</b> MODERATE	High numbers of infected mosquitoes in most areas, at least one confirmed human case.	Reduce, Repel, Report
<b>3</b> HIGH	Multiple confirmed human cases in DuPage County.	Reduce, Repel, Report

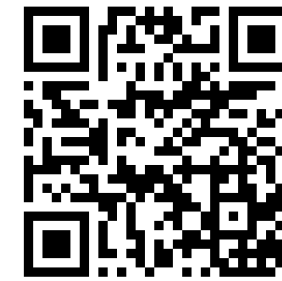
